Census data is used to distribute more than \$675 billion in federal funds to support states, counties and communities. That money is spent on schools, healthcare, roads and other vital programs.

Telephone, Internet, *mail or *enumerator
*Depending on location

4. Who needs to be counted?



A member of the household must list all members living in their respective property.

5. Will there be a citizenship question on the Census?

6. How do I identify Census employees?

Field Representatives will hold:



- ID badge
 - Official Bag and/or Laptop with Census Bureau Logo
 - Letter from Census Bureau Stating Visit
- Visits will be between 9am and 9pm, 7days a week.

7. Which address should I use when responding to the Census questionnaire?

Where you live the majority of time.



8. Will my information be shared?

NO. Under Title 13 of the U.S. Code, the Census Bureau cannot release any identifiable information. The law states that the information collected may only be used for statistical purposes and no other purpose.
